**Dogs must be at least 6 months of age to enter this trial.**

Soon after close of entries you will receive confirmation via email or US mail informing you if your entry was accepted. If your entry was accepted you will receive a judging program via email or US mail.

**IMPORTANT: Please note that due to AKC Rules and Regulations, Sheltie entries are required to be given first priority (Chapter 1, Section 2, Option 2 )**

## **ATTENTION EXHIBITORS:** (Please Read Carefully)

- Entry Fee** \$30.00 for the first entry of each dog (including \$3.00 AKC event service fee and \$.50 AKC recording fee) and \$26.00 for an additional entry of the same dog. Entries limited to 8 hours of judging.
- Closing Date** 12:00 Noon EST on Wednesday, February 21, 2017. After which entries cannot be accepted, canceled or substituted as provided for in chapter 11, section 6 of the dog show rules.
- Show Obedience Trial** will be open from 8:00 am to 6:00 pm. Exhibitor set up is at 7:30 am and not before.
- Returned checks** do not constitute a valid entry fee. Entries accompanied by returned checks will be charged an additional \$30 fee.
- Entries received** without fees will not be accepted.
- Telegraph, telephone and unsigned entries cannot be accepted.**
- Entries not on official AKC entry forms and photo copies of entry forms** without the agreement and rules on the reverse side of the official AKC entry form are **not acceptable**.
- Entry fee shall not be refunded** in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge or barred from competition by the show Committee. **No entry fee will be refunded** if the show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, and act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- Please include your jump height on your entry form.**
- Changes, additions, errors or corrections** to entry forms must be received in writing prior to the close of entries. Changes received by telephone are not accepted.
- There is no refund for duplicate entries or overpayments.** We will make every effort to find all duplicate entries, but if entry has been processed, no refund will be made
- This club does not agree** to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form for this event.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation** to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations
- Dogs may arrive at any time** prior to their scheduled time for judging, but not before opening show hour of 8:00 A.M. After being judged, dogs not required for further judging may be excused.
- Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class.** Owners or their agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings when their class is called to be judged. The show giving club, SSCNNJ, the committee and officers have no obligation or responsibility for providing service through public address system, steward or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.
- All dogs present must be kept on leash** or confined to their crates except when being judged in the ring or when in designated fenced exercise areas.
- There shall be no** drilling or intensive or abusive training of dogs on the show grounds.
- Rules for show grounds:** there will be limited crate space & no ex-pens in the building. Exhibitors may use the crates in the back room. Please clean up after your dogs----no exceptions! Do not put any dog waste in garbage can inside building. No dogs under 4 months of age on show grounds. Absolutely no parking on the street.
- The Shetland Sheepdog Club of Northern NJ and Golden Rule School for Dogs, officers and members, assume no responsibility** for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, spectators, or to any of their dogs, property, or children.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children.** Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the show Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any entry fee shall be made.
- DO NOT LEAVE DOGS IN CLOSED VEHICLES!!!** If any dog seems to be suffering from extreme temperatures or is confined without proper supervision the authorities will be notified to handle the situation. Violators may be reported to the trial committee and/or the AKC for disciplinary action. All persons attending this dog show hereby waive any claim for damages against Golden Rule School for Dogs or anyone associated with Shetland Sheepdog Club of Northern New Jersey in the event a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog from overheating, fire or suffocation due to improper ventilation.
- The club may cancel the event due to extreme weather conditions.** To find out about any AKC event cancellations call the AKC event cancellation hotline 877-252-3229
- Bitches in Season** Entry fees for bitches coming in season after entries close will be refunded only when exhibitors provide a letter from their veterinarian on business letterhead. It can be emailed or sent US mail to the trial secretary or presented to the trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of judging the first class.
- The SSCNNJ has approved that all club members are permitted to enter their dogs in any club trials.**

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## INSTRUCTIONS

1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
2. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. A or B division.
3. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
4. Dogs listed in the **AKC Canine Partners<sup>SM</sup> Program** may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC Obedience trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC Number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box. Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.

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## AGREEMENT
